IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ADORERS

We can have adoration if the following rules are adhered to:

1. Every visitor upon arrival must record in writing their name, phone number and time of visit
2. Please sanitise your hands before and after your visit
3. Disinfect the area you are in with the provided disinfectant and wipe down with paper towel before and after your visit
4. Only 10 people are allowed at any one time, so please be considerate and mindful of other adorers
5. Maintain social distancing of 1.5 metres

If we all follow the above guidelines, we will be able to continue with adoration. Please keep safe and adhere to the abovementioned rules.

Commencing Wednesday 27 May, adoration will be held on Wednesdays and Fridays 8am – 9am.
